Before Your Visit

Teachers and Chaperones

One teacher or adult chaperone is required for every 6 students.

Teachers and chaperones must remain with students they are supervising at all times.

Teachers and chaperones are responsible for maintaining discipline and ensuring that students are considerate of all visitors. Please respect our old and unique collection by:

- Walking (not running) on the campus and in exhibits, only climbing into boats or exhibits that expressly state you may do so.
- Keeping voice volume to a speaking level.
- We reserve the right to ask any disorderly group or individual to leave.
- Follow Museum guidelines in the Museum Store. Please allow a maximum of 12 children in the store at a time and assign two chaperones with the group to supervise at all times.

On the Day of Your Tour

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tour time.

Dress according to the weather and your activity, as tours and programs are held rain or shine. Also note that several layers of clothing should be worn for all boat cruises.

If you wish to eat lunch at the Museum, we have outdoor picnic tables and a drink machine on the grounds. Please use our trash and recycling containers.
