Silver Linings donates Chesapeake Bay bracelet for Maritime Museum raffle

The bracelet retails for \$280 and is on display at the museum's store now through September 10. Raffle tickets can be purchased at the store for \$5 each, or 5 for \$20. Tickets will also be sold during the September 10 Boating Party, where the winner's name will be drawn and announced.
