CBMM hosts Tidewater Camera Club photo exhibit beginning in May

The Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum (CBMM) in St. Michaels, MD will be exhibiting photos by Tidewater Camera Club (TCC) members May 3 through June 30 in the Van Lennep Auditorium of the Museum's Steamboat Gallery.

The series of photos features scenes from the Museum's 18-acre waterfront campus and working boat yard, as captured by TCC photographers during a recent outing to the Museum. The exhibit is free for Museum members or with admission.

CBMM's hosts several public and private receptions, classes and programs in the Van Lennep Auditorium throughout the year. Also at the Steamboat Gallery is the expanded, *A Rising Tide in the Heart of the Chesapeake* exhibit and *Illuminating the Sea: The Marine Paintings of James E. Buttersworth, 1844-1894*—a major retrospective exhibition highlighting the work of famed 19th-century marine artist James Edward Buttersworth (1844-1894). The *Rising Tide* exhibit features the photography of David Harp with text by Tom Horton, and continues through 2012. The *Buttersworth* exhibit, which is curated by Mystic Seaport, continues through October 16, 2011.
